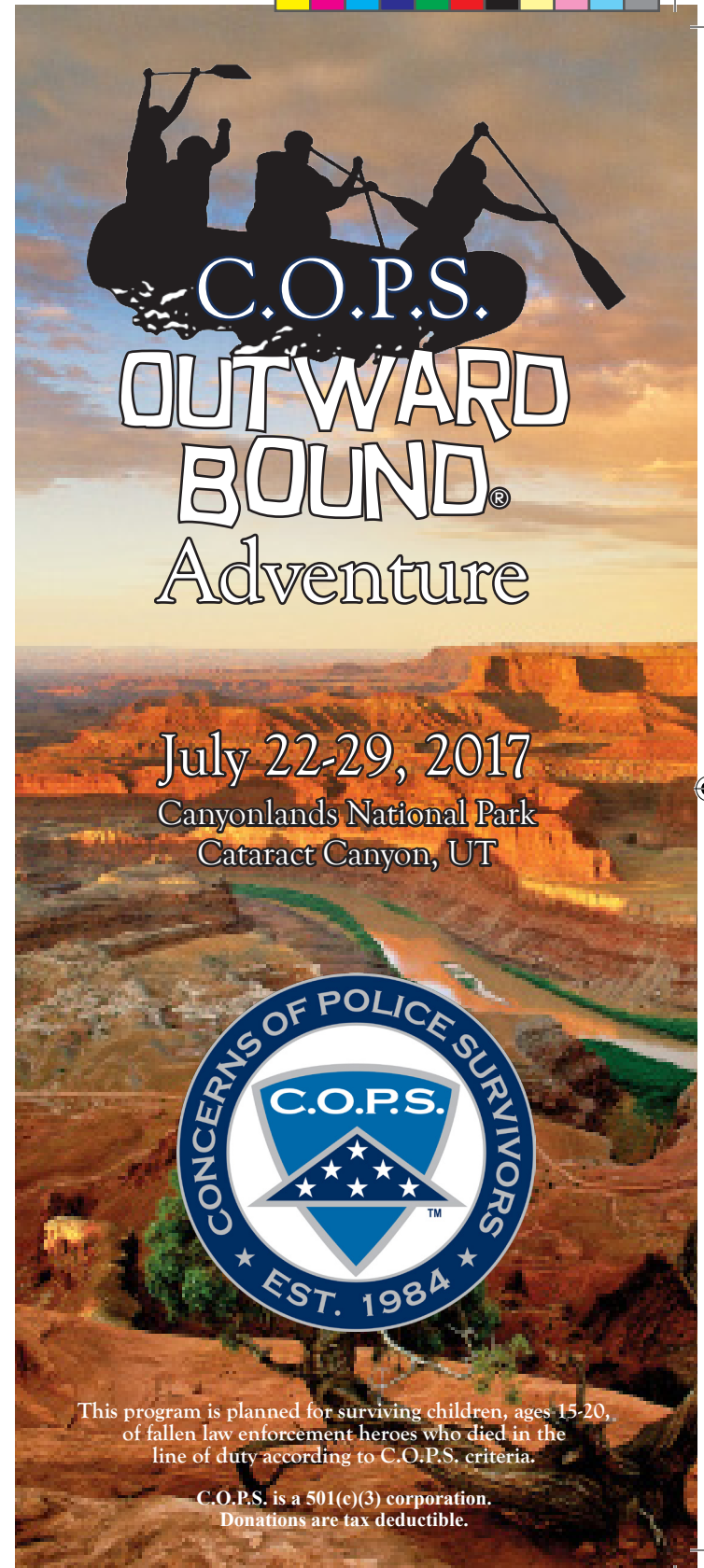

What is Outward Bound®?

Outward Bound® is an adventure-based program structured to inspire character development, self-discovery, compassion for others and to actively engage in creating a better world. C.O.P.S. Outward Bound® Adventure takes place on the Colorado River through the Cataract Canyon in the Canyonlands National Park in Utah.

Who can attend the adventure?

C.O.P.S. Outward Bound® Adventure is planned only for teenagers and young adults ages 15-20, who are children of law enforcement officers who died in the line of duty according to C.O.P.S. criteria. **Space is limited!**



When is Outward Bound®?

Due to the remote location of the activity, attendees will need to travel into Grand Junction, Colorado on Saturday, July 22 and depart out of Grand Junction on Saturday, July 29. **Please do not make any travel arrangements until you receive confirmation from CO.P.S. that you have been selected as a participant. First-time attendees will have preference over requests from returning participants.**

After confirmation, you can make travel arrangements to arrive in Grand Junction, Colorado, on Saturday, July 22 between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm. You will stay at a hotel, with adult supervision, until you launch onto the river the morning of July 23. Departures can be planned from Grand Junction after 1:30 pm on Saturday, July 29. If you must stay until July 30, you will be housed at the same hotel with adult supervision. Transportation will be provided from Grand Junction Airport to the hotel, launch site, and return site.

What is the cost?

You are responsible for your travel to and from Grand Junction, Colorado as well as some required supplies. You will receive a list of required and suggested supplies after your registration is confirmed. Providing your credit card information will serve as a deposit for participation in this program. If you attend the retreat as planned, C.O.P.S. will not charge your credit card. If you fail to cancel your reservation or do not show up for the program, your card could be charged a percentage of the cost per participant. A copy of the C.O.P.S. Cancellation Policy will be sent to you after we receive your registration request. **Deadline for registration is June 22, 2017. Registrations will not be accepted after the deadline date.**

Code of Conduct

In order to provide a safe environment for all participants, C.O.P.S. has established and utilizes a Code of Conduct. Failure to abide by this code is cause for immediate expulsion from the program. Cost of expulsion will be the responsibility of the affected participant. C.O.P.S. and its counselors reserve the right to pre-qualify applicants and excuse those who may not be suitable for the program. All decisions concerning participation shall be final. A copy of the Code of Conduct will be sent to you after we receive your registration request.

Important Update: *Outward Bound® 2017 begins on Saturday, July 22 and ends on Saturday, July 29. This is a change from past years, as this retreat has always started on a Sunday and ended on a Sunday.*

This event is organized by National C.O.P.S. The sale of merchandise for any cause other than National C.O.P.S. is strictly prohibited. All merchandise sold or distributed at any Hands-On Program must be approved by National C.O.P.S. prior to the program.
